We are meeting for the Sally Ride Fest Training on the 15th of April at Wonderscope Children's museum from 6:00-7:30 PM. Location:



Update your Membership Profile online! Please check the online database for the accuracy of personal information such as mailing address, email address, receiving the SWE magazine, and more. This will enhance our ability to distribute SWE Section information.

Do you Qualify for Senior Member Grade?

Senior Member According to our bylaws, any person who is or has been actively engaged in the profession of engineering is eligible to become a Senior Member if at the time of application or advancement she/he qualifies under one of the following classifications:

(a) Holds a degree in engineering from a recognized college or university and has at least six years of increasingly important engineering experience.

(b) Holds a degree in a science related to engineering from a recognized college or university and has at least six years of increasingly important engineering experience.

c) Has at least 11 years of increasingly important engineering experience indicating engineering competency and achievement.

(d) Anyone who receives the SWE Achievement Award is automatically made a Senior Member, except that a Fellow of the Society who has received the SWE Achievement Award shall retain the Fellow grade.

## **ONLINE INSTRUCTIONS:**

Go to www.swe.org < www.swe.org> , Scroll down to Membership, click on "Benefits of Membership", click on "Member Services".

On the left side of the screen, click, "Update Member Profile" or "Membership Upgrade." It will ask you for your User ID and Password to enter the system and check/change your profile or fill out the upgrade form.

If you missed the mailing of your User ID and Password, click on "forgot password". As long as your email address matches the database email address, you will be automatically be emailed your User ID and Password. Save a buck or two by becoming a lifetime member! All membership dues are going up July 1, 2003. Regular membership renewal fee will be 100 dollars for the new fiscal year. Apply now and get lifetime membership for the rate of \$1500 versus the new rate of \$2000 in July. Payment plans are available.
